



2023 – 24 Fees & Payment Schedule

Fees are **\$700** for the Symphonic Orchestra and **\$650** for the Concert Orchestra. Training Program fees are **\$425**, or you may sign up for one semester at a time (**\$200 for September - December 2023, \$260 for January – June 2024**).

Available Discounts:

We are offering a \$50 discount for those musicians who register by August 20, 2023. We are also offering a 10% new member discount throughout the 2023-24 season (*please note: discounts do not stack*).

- When e-transferring, please include in the note the name of the member, what ensemble they play in, and if it's full payment or what number of installment. ("name", symphonic/concert/training, and full/installment #).
